OASIS has created a new program, *RecycleMyComputer*, to refurbish old computer equipment and donate it to low-income adults in the Washington area.

Clean out your house and help your community at the same time

- Keep usable computer equipment out of local landfills.
- Provide computer equipment to people who can't afford it, with a priority on low-income seniors.

Types of equipment you can donate

- **COMPUTERS.** Computers don't have to be working, but they should be capable of running Windows 2000 or Windows XP. How do you know? There's generally a sticker on the front of the computer. Look for the words *Windows 2000*, *Windows XP*, *Windows Vista*, *Pentium 3*, or *Pentium 4*. The volunteers at *RecycleMyComputer* will remove all the data from the computer, refurbish it, and install new software.
- **OTHER EQUIPMENT.** All other computer equipment (monitors, printers, speakers, scanners, etc.) must be in working condition.

Where to drop off your donation

Bring your computer equipment to the *RecycleMyComputer* office at 4805 Edgemoor Lane (second floor), Bethesda, Maryland, between 12:00 noon and 3:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. A map and directions to our office are available at <http://tinyurl.com/26bfevj>.

We'll be happy to give you a receipt for your equipment. All donations are tax-deductible.

Other ways you can help *RecycleMyComputer*

You can direct needy Washington-area residents to our program. Although anyone may apply to receive a donation from us, seniors will be given priority. Applicants should call OASIS at 301-469-6800 to request an application form. Approved applicants will have to pay a \$10 administrative fee and pick up their computers at the *RecycleMyComputer* office (we don't deliver).
